ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE INDICATOR PERFORMANCE BASED APPRAISAL SYSTEM FOR SELECTION OF PRINCIPALS OF GOVERNMENT – AIDED COLLEGES OF WEST BENGAL (ADVT. NO. 2/2015)

An applicant who is currently working as a Principal/TIC should have the relevant portions of his/her API along with certificates/testimonials authenticated by the President of the concerned Governing Body. In other cases, the concerned Principal/TIC is also competent to authenticate a candidate's credentials insofar as College related performance is concerned.

Applicants against WBCSC's Advertisement No. 2/ 2015 for the post of Principal must submit the filled in API pro-forma with score calculation (annexed with the printout of application form) to the Commission's office by 10/09/2015 (4 PM). This is very important because the API Score is a crucial component of the eligibility-cum-selection criteria and therefore, accuracy in filling up the API is very important for one's candidature.. Candidates are requested to read the following instructions and the format carefully before filling in the pro-forma.

- The data (for Sl. No. 1 9) should relate to the period 01.09.2012 31.08.2015 (except Sl. No. 6)
- No column should be left blank. Please write 'NA' in the column not related to you.
- Attach verifiable documents in exactly the samer sequence as of the API in favour of your submission/s, such as
 Certificates from proper authority, Papers published etc (self attested photo copies only). HOWEVER, PLEASE DO
 NOT ENCLOSE PHOTOCOPIES OF THE ENTIRE published work. Only those pages that reveal the author name(s), the
 ISSN/ISBN no. etc. should be enclosed.
- Original Testimonials/documents should be produced before the interview board. It may be noted that failure to
 produce original documents may lead to the cancellation of candidature. The published work in original should also
 be brought for perusal by experts during interview.
- All entries must be made by the candidate himself/herself in his/her own handwriting.
- Any wrong or unauthenticated declaration will be dealt with as per rules and may lead to cancellation of candidature.
- Calculation of scores must be done in accordance with the instruction/s given in each item. In no case 'score claimed.' should exceed the stipulated 'Maximum score' as given.
- CANDIDATES MUST SCORE A MINIMUM OF 400 POINTS IN ORDER TO ATTAIN ELIGIBILITY.

Clarifications regarding API

1. Category I and II

Please note that a candidate has to justify all claims made by him/her regarding the API. In respect of the items covered under SI. No. 1-9, which basically deal with the performance of the candidate within his/her own institution, the competent authority should validate the claims.

It is advisable that the candidates use a separate sheet of paper to make a list of their activities item wise, which the concerned authrority may authenticate. Otherwise, the said authority may issue a certificate that adequately covers the relevant points. For e.g., the activities in which the applicant had been involved (NSS/NSC, Sports, Cultural activity etc.- SI. No. 7) or the Committees where a candidate had actively participated in (IQAC, Academic Sub Committee etc.- SI. No. 8) may be listed separately and certified.

There is, however, no need to submit copies of attendance register or attach all examination duty slips; the competent authority's certification will be accepted even if unaccompanied by such 'back-up' documents.

2. Category III

The 'Cap' is the maximum points that can be claimed under different "heads" of category III. The idea behind this 'cap' is to have a 'balanced' API score, not unduly skewed towards one single parameter, so that the total under one item <u>does not exceed</u> a certain percentage of the cumulative API score. The experts in the selection committee will of course, check whether any score has crossed the relevant threshold or not, but to facilitate their task, <u>candidates are requested to present a break up of their total API score</u> in the following manner(in a separate sheet attached at the end of the document).
